

Electrical and electronic (EE) waste comprises discarded electrical and electronic equipment and electric appliances. By properly disposing of EE waste, we are preserving our health and enabling the utilisation of precious metals and plastics required for the manufacture of new devices.

EE equipment retailer selling EE equipment whose store is larger than 400 m² has the obligation to put up, in a visible place at the entrance, the label informing the customers about the EE equipment take-back scheme.



Let's acquire the habit and separate waste!


EE's how it's done!

Think about it: Every year around the world 300 million computers and 1 billion mobile phones are sold, and 80% end up at the landfills. Computers and smartphones consist of elements that are harmful to human health, such as lead, mercury, cadmium, beryllium and arsenic – which is the reason why they have to be collected and transported separately from other waste.

What to do with electrical and electronic appliances you no longer need?

Make sure to dispose of old electrical and electronic equipment in one of the four proper ways:



FREE OF CHARGE

25 cm



1.

Appliances up to 25 cm in size can be handed over free of charge at the store bearing the sign "EE waste take-back" with no obligation to purchase



2.

Larger old home appliances can be handed over at the shops when you buy new appliances,



3.

Can be taken free of charge to the civic amenity site (recycling yard)



4.

Free transport can be arranged with an authorised collector. The list of collectors is available at www.fzoeu.hr



You can drop off light bulbs at any store which sells them, regardless of its size.



Repair shops are obliged to take over on their business premises EE equipment for which repair is impossible or commercially unviable.



EE equipment is marked with this label.
